Welcome to Torquay Summer Camp, everyone, and welcome back to all of you who attended the international summer school here last year. It's great to see all these new faces and a few old ones, too. My name's Marina Vasey and I'm the accommodation and entertainment secretary. Basically, that means I'm in charge of student's rooms and after-school activities. So my job is to make sure you're all happy with your rooms and that you settle comfortably.

Now that you've all unpacked, I'd just like to run through the main rules.

As you know, you'll be staying here for two months so we do understand that you will want to put some decorations on your walls. That's fine. You can put posters and photos on the walls but we do ask you not to use drawing pins. You should use Safe Tape, which you can buy at the reception. It's easy to use and it doesn't leave marks on the walls.

On the subject of food and drink in your rooms, obviously you can take drinks, sweets and chocolate into your rooms. We have a small shop and the opening hours are from 3 p.m. to 5 p.m. But eating proper meals in your rooms is not allowed. If you aren't eating in the canteen, you can make a light snack in one of the kitchens in your block, but you must not bring food into the bedrooms.

Now music. You must not use your sound system after 10 p.m. Please be considerate about noise in the evenings. Most of you have brought your mobile phones with you.

Obviously you are allowed to use them in your rooms and in the garden. But we would like you to turn your mobiles off in class and in the dining rooms.

You can invite your friends to your rooms but your guests have to leave by 10 p.m. If you want to stay out after 10 p.m., you have to collect a front door key from my office.

You will find a list of activities and excursions for the week outside my office. You don't have to take part in any of the after-school activities or excursions. If you are interested in any, you must sign-up in my office at least one day in advance. Fishing in the lake is not allowed. If you want to use the boats or windsurfers, please ask a sports instructor first, he will be happy to help you.

"The Rock Garden of Chandigarh"

In Chandigarh, a **I city** in northeast India, there is an amazing garden. There are tall rocks and small **B paths** between them. There are waterfalls, pools, and hundreds of sculptures. The sculptures are surprising because they are all made from **F rubbish**, like plastic jewellery, bottles, broken pots, sinks, toilets, and pieces of electrical equipment.

The garden has a surprising history too because it was **H built** in secret! A man called Nek Chand started building the garden in 1957. He chose some land in a forest near the city, where there were rocks and a river. Nobody was allowed to build here, so Nek knew that people wouldn't see him there. Then he started to collect rubbish and make the **E sculptures**.

Nek's project was **A illegal**, but for 18 years, nobody found it. However, in 1975, some government officials discovered it. By that time, the garden was nearly 49,000m² in size. The government tried to **D destroy** the garden, but when the people in the city heard about it, they wanted to keep it.

In 1976 it became a public park. After that, Nek Chand received a **J salary** so that he could work in the garden full-time, and fifty more people were employed to work there with him. People paid to visit the garden. Nek put collection centres around the town so that he could make more recycled sculptures.

However, the garden wasn't safe yet. In 1990, the local **C government** tried to build a road through the park, just for VIPs. But local people protested, and their plan failed. Later, Nek became famous. He **G travelled** to the USA to tell people about his garden. But when he returned, his garden was destroyed! It took a long time to rebuild it and keep it safe.

Now, a charity manages the garden. Five thousand visitors visit this special place each day. Volunteers, workers, and local children still work here. They keep the garden clean and learn to make sculptures. If you like, you can volunteer here too!
