

Corona virus: Information on vaccination in the Canton of Zurich

As of April 28, 2021

Vaccination is voluntary and free.

Can I be vaccinated?

Yes, if you

- you are over 16 years of age
- you don't have a fever or any other COVID 19 symptoms
- you don't have an allergy against one of the components of the vaccine (PEG)
- you are not in isolation or quarantine

Pregnant women, breastfeeding mothers, allergy sufferers with a severe reaction in the past and people with severe immune suppression must consult their doctor before being vaccinated. For a vaccination at the vaccination centre, you need a medical certificate.

Can I register for vaccination now?

Vaccination appointments are allocated according to the prioritisation specified by the FOPH. The vaccination groups open for booking appointments can be found at [zh.ch/coronaimpfung](https://www.zh.ch/coronaimpfung).

People with chronic illnesses are advised to consult their doctor.
