

ICT PROFICIENCY ASSESSMENT AND JOB APPLICATION TRAINING/COACHING

This modular program focuses on specialists and professionals in the field of ICT and aims to help them to develop a job application strategy that will bring them success. It begins with an assessment to determine each participant's employability. Building on this, further modules can be selected as needed. Individual assignments are set to ensure the practical application of the theory learnt in these various modules.

TARGET GROUP

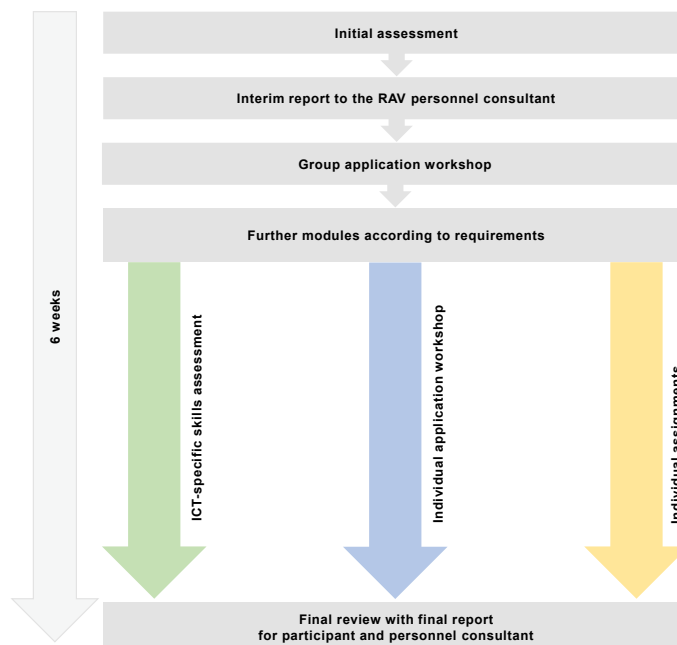
Educated ICT professionals, managers and career changers with at least three years of recent experience in the IT industry in one of the following occupational areas of ICT as defined by swissICT:

- Planning, Control and Consulting (PLAN)
- Design, Engineering, Provision and Implementation (BUILD)
- Operations, Administration and Support (RUN)
- Project Management (PM)
- Organization (ORG)
- Methodology-related Professions (AGILE)

REQUIREMENTS

- A native language other than German
- English skills corresponding to at least CEFR level B2
- PC infrastructure: Internet access, word processing and accessories for video conferencing (camera and microphone)

PROGRAM STRUCTURE



INITIAL ASSESSMENT

One-to-one setting, 1 meeting

- Proficiency assessment (employment history, qualifications, skills and personality)
- Drawing up an action plan

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GROUP APPLICATION WORKSHOP

Group setting, 5 half-days

- Successful job applications in the ICT job market
- Optimizing your application documents
- Cover letter & search and application strategy
- Online/social media job search & elevator pitch
- Job interviews

Based on the «Inverted Classroom» teaching method, the participants work through the learning content in self-study with the help of the Learning Management System. The workshop builds on this knowledge and is designed to be learner-centered. Further questions are discussed in plenary sessions or in small groups, exercises are worked on with immediate feedback. The focus is on the exchange among the participants. Participation in the application workshop is mandatory for everyone and forms the shared foundation.

FINAL REVIEW WITH FINAL REPORT

One-to-one setting, 1 meeting

- Summarizing the measures that have been implemented in accordance with the action plan
- Checking the completeness of the application dossier
- Determining the level of maturity achieved by the participant in terms of job application expertise
- Discussing the results of the professional assessment
- Obtaining the participant's evaluation of the program

FURTHER MODULES

ICT-SPECIFIC SKILLS ASSESSMENT

One-to-one setting, 1 meeting

- Exploring subject-specific formal and informal qualifications
- Identifying the need for further qualification measures to regain employability

INDIVIDUAL APPLICATION TRAINING

One-to-one setting, a maximum of 3 meetings

- Reflecting on the participant's current approach to job applications and consequent level of success
- Preparing the participant for actual job interviews
- Addressing personality-oriented topics and those connected to the participant's employment history
- Transforming the knowledge acquired in the training sessions into actual promising job applications
- Completion of the application dossier

INDIVIDUAL ASSIGNMENTS

Testing and implementing the knowledge, skills and abilities acquired in the ongoing job application process
